- None of the routes is barrier-free!
- We recommend that all JOURNEY TIME participants wear sturdy shoes and bring along something to drink.
- Anyone taking Routes 2 and 4 must bring along a valid passport!
- All of the routes' itineraries include lengthy stops for meals and snacks. A multi-course lunch costs about €10; cake and coffee about €5.
